State treasurer meets with Clermont County leaders

Ohio Treasurer Josh Mandel joined Clermont County area small businesses and community leaders on Tuesday to provide an update on the Ohio Treasurer's office and to hear their thoughts on job creation and economic development in Ohio.

"Traveling the state and meeting with local business leaders allows me to take what I've learned and share with policy makers in Columbus," Treasurer Mandel said. "These local small business leaders in Clermont County are important to the success of Ohio's economy and it is important that their voice is heard."

The business roundtable was held at Lykins Oil in Milford and discussions ranged from topics like creating an environment that fosters job growth to workforce development ideas.

In addition to talks on job creation, Treasurer Mandel updated the attendees on his office's STAR Plus program, which is a local government investment option.
