The session will not only cover the requirements of these standards, but also will provide insights into potential implementation issues. Statement No, 87, Leases, was approved by GASB in June 2017 and is effective for reporting periods beginning after Dec. 15, 2019. Statement No. 84, <i>Fiduciary Activities</i>, was approved by GASB in January 2017 and is effective for reporting periods beginning after Dec. 15, 2018. These standards will have a profound effect on state and local governments. Due to the significance and complexity of leases and fiduciary activities, these standards cannot be implemented at the last minute. They will need careful planning, and the time to plan is now.</p> <p>Nonverbal Communication – The topic of nonverbal communication is widely addressed in many of today's popular business publications and blogs. Most researchers agree that between 60% and 90% of our messages are communicated nonverbally. Still, many of us don't understand the impact of our nonverbal messages. Even more concerning is the fact that we are often unaware of the nonverbal messages we are sending. In this session, we will discuss what nonverbal communication is all about and learn how we can increase our awareness and use of nonverbal messages to increase the effectiveness of our communication</p>
