OhioCheckbook.gov combines two first-of-their-kind websites

OhioCheckbook.com and Ohio's Interactive Budget have been merged into one easy-to-use online portal. Taxpayers now have a single source for accessing robust spending data related to Ohio's state and local governments.



New Design

OhioCheckbook.gov retains the best features of its predecessor websites while introducing new components to enhance navigation across the site.



Daily Reporting

Detailed state revenue data featured on OhioCheckbook.gov is pulled directly from the state's OAKS system and is updated daily.



Expense Breakdowns

Users can customize search queries to drill into specific areas and details about local and state government spending.

Day-to-day management of OhioCheckbook.gov is administered in collaboration between the Ohio Treasurer's office and the Office of Budget and Management (OBM) with the support of the Office of Information Technology (OIT).
