OPERS Board of Trustees Update Stewart A Smith, Director of Finance, Columbus Metropolitan Library	This will be a brief update about the Ohio Public Employees Retirement System (OPERS) and its Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees is responsible for the administration and management of OPERS. The board meets monthly to review and formulate policies concerning the members, contributors and benefit recipients of OPERS, and the OPERS office staff. While elected by a specific group, all members of the Board of Trustees have a fiduciary duty to act solely in the interest of all members of the system, not just those that elected them. The board members also authorize the investments made with the system's funds.
