



FOUNDATION FOR APPALACHIAN OHIO'S iSEE PROJECT

In partnership with the Foundation for Appalachian Ohio, Vision to Learn, and the Ohio Optometric Foundation, ResultsOHIO is helping to expand access to vision care and services for school children across 32 Appalachian counties throughout Ohio.

As the inaugural effort launched under the ResultsOHIO model, the Foundation for Appalachian Ohio's iSee project uses a mobile vision clinic to provide school-site vision care to Ohio students. Service delivery includes vision screenings, eye exams, and new prescriptions glasses – all free of charge to the students and their families.

The project is scheduled to run from the start of the 2021-22 school year into the 2022-23 school year and aims to increase service delivery and remove barriers to receiving eye exams in high need areas.

The University of Cincinnati Evaluation Services Center is serving as the project's independent evaluator and has been tasked with measuring performance outcomes to determine whether or not desired results have been achieved.

The iSEE project fittingly illustrates the benefits of taking a pay for success approach to problem-solving. Through ResultsOHIO we're able to bring new, innovative ideas to the table to solve some of the most challenging issues in our communities, and taxpayer dollars are only used if a project has proven to be successful.
