## Additional Feasibility Reports Released

Earlier this week, Ohio Treasurer Robert Sprague announced two additional project proposals deemed "Pay-for-Success Appropriate and Ready" through the [ResultsOHIO program](#).

In January, the Treasurer's office released its first round of evaluations to determine whether proposed projects would be a good fit for the PFS project delivery and financing structure. Five projects were determined to be "PFS Appropriate and Ready" and issued ResultsOHIO Feasibility Reports.

Applications that went through the first round of evaluations and were "PFS Appropriate, but Not Ready" were eligible to revise and resubmit an application for additional evaluation.

Based on the resubmissions, two projects have been determined to be "PFS Appropriate and Ready" and issued ResultsOHIO Feasibility Reports. Feasibility Reports contain an analysis of the project from the Treasurer's office that applicants can utilize to advocate for funding.
